With the funds we raised last year at the Gala event held at Bet Hadassah we launched the SHERUT Le'UMI Program. As you might remember this program is an alternative to serving in the Israeli army. It engages highly motivated and idealistic military age citizens in community-based work.

Because most of the social services and educational institutions in Tiberias lack the proper funding necessary to maintain their regular operations and certainly can not afford the services of the Benot Sherut the Maimonides Heritage Center with YOUR help commissioned 35 young women and brought them into the city of Tiberias to work in the community. **The results were hugely successful!** These girls spent one and a half days of the week studying at the Center and the rest of the week was devoted to work and service in the city of Tiberias.
